3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Data Mapping to Save  
5       Moms’ Lives Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MAPPING BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY AND MATER-**  
2 **NAL HEALTH OUTCOMES.**

3 (a) INCORPORATION OF MATERNAL HEALTH OUT-  
4 COME DATA.—The Federal Communications Commission  
5 shall incorporate data on maternal health outcomes for not  
6 less than 1 year postpartum, as recommended by the Cen-  
7 ters for Disease Control and Prevention under subsection  
8 (b), into the broadband health mapping tools of the Com-  
9 mission.

10 (b) CONSULTATION WITH CDC.—The Federal Com-  
11 munications Commission shall consult with the Centers for  
12 Disease Control and Prevention regarding the maternal  
13 health outcomes that should be incorporated into the  
14 broadband health mapping tools of the Commission under  
15 subsection (a).
